2006 PINOT NOIR Freshly picked strawberries, raspberry jam and rhubarb aromas interweave a core of cream soda, nutmeg and cinnamon. The soft tannins finish with a kiss of toasted oak and sassafras. Bottled August of 2007.	\$45 / \$36	_____
2003 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 1.5L (MAGNUM) The still fresh, rich, concentrated, raspberry jam flavors are enriched by a savory oak tone that frames the wine's long fruitful finish as a result of a mild Winter and classic Autumn. Bottled May of 2005.	\$90 / \$72	_____
2001 LIBRARY CABERNET SAUVIGNON Complex bouquet reminiscent of a classified Bordeaux growth. A mature velvety palate delivers soft round flavors of black licorice, fig, oregano and pepper spice. Cellared and re-released to the mature collector. Bottled May of 2003.	\$80 / \$64	_____
2003 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON Inky, deep purple in color this wine is redolent of ripe black cherry, dark plum, cassis, cola, chocolate and leather. The lush palate is concentrated with flavors of blackberry, clove, black cherry and sweet oak leading to a long, lingering finish.
